

## Racial Profiling Comparative Analysis for 2012

### **1. Total number of vehicle stops or contacts: 3346**

Of the total number of stops (3364) 2522 could be classified as racial or ethnic minorities (this amounts to 75.4% of the total number of vehicle contacts). This overall percentage is based on having identified those classes of ethnic or racial minorities within the total number of vehicle stops.

### **2. Comparative Analysis:**

Those identified as minorities include a total of 870 African Americans (or 26.0% of all stops) and 1520 Hispanic Americans (or 45.4% of all stops). A comparative analysis based on the most recent population statistics for the City of Kirby demonstrates these minority contacts are slightly above (5.3%) the general population demographic estimates. While non-minority contacts were slightly below (5.3%). The most recent data available for the City of Kirby population demographics by ethnic or racial class suggests the percentage of African Americans within the overall population is 14.1% and 52.8% for Hispanic Americans. The remainder of the stops conducted were 3.9% Asian and 24.6% Caucasian. Stops made were predominately male (1977 {59.1%} male and 1369 {40.9%} female).

### **3. Disposition of Stops:**

Disposition of stops made by officers includes the issuance of citations for violations totaling: 2212 citations and 1134 written warnings. 240 searches were conducted as a result of vehicle stops; 81 stops that subsequently lead to a lawful arrest, 138 searches were subsequent to a vehicle impoundment, and 21

were released with no further action being taken by the officer. The searches resulted in 21 instances where illegal drugs or drug paraphernalia was seized. Officers also seized 2 illegal handguns and recovered one piece of stolen property.

No racial profiling complaints were received by the department for the 2012 reporting period. Information contained within this analysis will be covered as part of our department's monthly officer training meeting.
