

Racial profiling Comparative Analysis for 2013

Total Number of Vehicle Stops or Contacts: 2950

Of the total number of stops (2950), 2194 were be classified as racial or ethnic minorities (this amounts to 74.3% of the total number of vehicle stops or contacts). This overall percentage is based on having identified those classes of ethnic or racial minorities within the total number of vehicle stops or contacts.

Comparative Analysis:

Those identified as minorities include a total of 664 African Americans (22.5%) and 1427 Hispanic Americans (48.3%). A comparative analysis of the most recent population statistics for the City of Kirby demonstrates these minority contacts are slightly higher (4.1%) than the general population demographic estimates. While non-minority are slightly below (4.3%) the same demographic estimates. The most recent population data for the City of Kirby suggests that the percentage of African American within the overall population is 14.1% and 52.8% for Hispanic Americans. The remainder of the stops included 3.4% Asian and 25.6% Caucasian. As in 2013, stops were predominately male with 1644 {55.7%} men being stopped as opposed to 1306 {44.2%} woman.

Disposition of the Stops:

Disposition of the stops made by officers includes the issuance of citations and warnings totaling: 1623 citations, and 1327 warnings. 266 searches were conducted as a result of the stops. 114 stops subsequently lead to a lawful arrest, 184 searches were subsequent to a vehicle impoundment, and 19 searches resulted in the seizure of illegal drugs or drug paraphernalia.

During the 2013 reporting period, no racial profiling complaints were received by the department.

Information contained within this analysis will be discussed with the officers at a scheduled patrol meeting in April.
