Article 2.132 (b) CCP Law Enforcement Policy on Racial Profiling

VIA METROPOLITIAN TRANSIT POLICE DEPARTMENT has adopted a detailed written policy on racial profiling. Our policy:

- (1) Clearly defines acts constituting racial profiling;
- (2) Strictly prohibits peace officers employed by the VIA METROPOLITIAN TRANSIT POLICE DEPARTMENT from engaging in racial profiling.
- (3) Implements a process by which an individual may file a complaint with the VIA METROPOLITIAN TRANSIT POLICE DEPARTMENT if the individual believes that a peace officer employed with the VIA METROPOLITIAN TRANSIT POLICE DEPARTMENT has engaged in racial profiling;
- (4) Provides public education relating to the agency's complainant process;
- (5) Requires appropriate corrective action to be taken against a peace officer employed by the VIA METROPOLITIAN TRANSIT POLICE DEPARTMENT. Who, after an investigation, is shown to have engaged in racial profiling in violation of VIA METROPOLITIAN TRANSIT POLICE DEPARTMENT's policy adopted under this article;
- (6) Require collection of information relating to motor vehicle stops in which a citation is issued and to arrests made as a result of those stops, including information relating to:
  - (A) The race or ethnicity of the individual detained;
  - (B) Whether a search was conducted and, if so, whether the individual detained consented to the search; and
  - (C) Whether the peace officer knew the race or ethnicity of the individual detained before the detaining the individual; and

- (7) Require the chief administrator of the agency, regardless of whether the administrator is elected, employed, or appointed, to submit to an annual report of the information collected under subsection (6) to:
  - (A) The Commission on Law Enforcement Officer Standards and Education; and
  - (B) The governing body of each county or municipality served by the agency, if the agency is an agency of a county, municipality, or other political subdivision of the state.
