**Certification to Report 2.132 (Tier 2)**

**Policy Requirements (2.132(b) CCP):**

**Each law enforcement agency in this state shall adopt a detailed written policy on racial profiling. The policy must:**

- (1) clearly define acts constituting racial profiling;
- (2) strictly prohibit peace officers employed by the agency from engaging in racial profiling;
- (3) implement a process by which an individual may file a complaint with the agency if the individual believes that a peace officer employed by the agency has engaged in racial profiling with respect to the individual;
- (4) provide public education relating to the agency's complaint process;
- (5) require appropriate corrective action to be taken against a peace officer employed by the agency who, after an investigation, is shown to have engaged in racial profiling in violation of the agency's policy adopted under this article;
- (6) require collection of information relating to motor vehicle stops in which a citation is issued and to arrests made as a result of those stops, including information relating to:
  - (A) the race or ethnicity of the individual detained;
  - (B) whether a search was conducted and, if so, whether the individual detained consented to the search; and
  - (C) whether the peace officer knew the race or ethnicity of the individual detained before detaining that individual; and
- (7) require the chief administrator of the agency, regardless of whether the administrator is elected, employed, or appointed, to submit an annual report of the information collected under Subdivision (6) to:
  - (A) the Commission on Law Enforcement Officer Standards and Education; and
  - (B) the governing body of each county or municipality served by the agency, if the agency is an agency of a county, municipality, or other political subdivision of the state.

Article 2.132(b) CCP Law Enforcement Policy on Racial Profiling

EL PASO COUNTY OFFICE OF THE CONSTABLE PRECINCT #1 has adopted a written policy on Racial Profiling.

Our policy:

- (1) Clearly defines acts constituting racial profiling;
- (2) Strictly prohibit peace officers employed by the EL PASO COUNTY OFFICE OF THE CONSTABLE PRECINCT #1 from engaging in racial profiling;
- (3) Implements a process by which anyone person(s) may file a complaint with the EL PASO COUNTY OFFICE OF THE CONSTABLE PRECINCT #1. if the individual believes that a peace officer employed by the PASO COUNTY OFFICE OF THE CONSTABLE PRECINCT #1 has engaged in racial profiling with respect to the individual;
- (4) Direct the Public to additional resources relating to the agency's complaint process;
- (5) Requires appropriate corrective action to be taken against a peace officer employed by the EL PASO COUNTY, OFFICE OF THE CONSTABLE PRECINCT #1, who, after an investigation, is shown to have engaged in racial profiling in violation of the EI PASO COUNTY, OFFICE OF THE CONSTABLE PRECINCT #1 policy adopted under this article;
- (6) mandated collection of data relating to motor vehicle stops in which a citation is issued and to arrests made as a result of those stops, including Data relating to:
  - (A) The race or ethnicity of the individual detained;
  - (B) Whether a search was conducted and, if so, whether the individual detained consented to the search; and Page 1 of 5 pages submitted electronically to the Texas Commission on Law Enforcement Officer Standards and Education;
  - (C) Whether the peace officer knew the race or ethnicity of the individual detained before detaining that individual; and
  - (7) require the chief administrator of the agency, regardless of whether the administrator is elected, employed, or appointed, to submit an annual report of the information collected under Subdivision;
- (6) to:
  - (A) The Commission on Law Enforcement Officer Standards and Education; and
  - (B) The governing body of each county or municipality served by the agency, if the agency is an agency of a county, municipality, or other political subdivision of the state.

EL PASO COUNTY, OFFICE OF THE CONSTABLE PRECINCT #1 has submitted electronically the analysis in PDF format required by 2.134 CCP(c) which contains;
